MONTH	THEME/TOPIC	INSPIRATION	GOALS	DESCRIPTION
January/ February	Value Studies	INNESS	Build painting habit with daily value studies (+/- 30mins)	Work on painting simple black and white value studies from basic landscape images.
March/ April	Skies	LEVITAN	Continue working on value studies, work on two sky scapes every weekend.	Begin working on small landscapes with a focus on learning to paint simple skies and clouds.
May/ June	Mountains	HAES	Continue value studies, skies, and start working on mountains and hills.	Your value studies should be improving, on the weekends use one day to work on skies and one day to work on mountains or hills.
July/ August	Trees	CHURCH	Start learning different ways to paint trees and experiment.	Bring different elements together, follow tutorials on landscapes that include trees and maybe water.
September/ October	Water	FRIEDRICH	Practice painting water, learn to paint waves, lakes and small rivers.	Each weekend spend one day on full scapes and one day on a water study in particular.
November/ December	Full Scapes	ECKENBRECHER	Continue value studies, on the weekends work on full scapes.	Each weekend paint two landscapes, focus on areas that need improvement!

Wednesday/ Thursday	Value Study	Work on short value studies, these should take no more than 30 minutes. Practice recognizing tones, basic shapes, and perspective.	Read or watch YouTube video on color theory for values and perspective.
Friday	Research	Work on value study, if you have time, work on one landscape through a tutorial.	Research 1 landscape painter and look for paintings you enjoy.
Saturday/ Sunday	Scapes	Follow tutorials on how to paint a specific part of the landscape, one Saturday and one Sunday.	YouTube has a ton of videos on different elements of landscape painting, you can also find step-by-step books.
